STYLE 1850

Style 1850 is produced from KYNOL* fibers by blending continuous KYNOL filaments with KYNOL staple fibers on the surface of each yarn. The yarns as well as the finished braid are impregnated with PTFE dispersion via Garlock's single-end coating process to make a tough, chemically resistant pump packing. The finished braid is also coated with a high temperature break-in lubricant.
